

It is our prayer that you and your family are doing well and staying healthy. We have been praying for you and for the US.

We are doing well, we are still adjusting to all the changes in C.R. due to Covid-19. This has been a difficult season but God keeps helping us each day. The Lord has kept us safe and we have seen Him work in many ways, in the lives of many, even in the midst of a pandemic. Here is a brief summary of some of the highlights of our ministry in the last 2 months.

Helping near 500

Covid has caused much death and sorrow in Latin America. In the midst of this, God has given Carlos the opportunity to bring the hope of Jesus, and tools and advice to near 500 people who are either grieving or helping someone who grieves.

Through many video conferences Carlos has met with over **200** public school teachers from **Guatemala** and **85** public school teachers in **Costa Rica**.

Carlos has also continued to help and equip missionaries all over Latin America. In the past 2 months Carlos has met with almost **200 Cru missionaries** from near 30 countries to provide them tools that would help them minister to others who are grieving.
