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**Say This**

Who is amazing?  
*Jesus is amazing.*

**Luke 5:1-10**

Jesus helps Peter catch enough fish to fill and almost sink two boats.

**Do This**



**Morning Time**

When you go into your child’s room, sit on their bed and say, “Good morning, sleepy head! We’re learning something new this month. Do you remember? We’re learning that Jesus (hold their feet) is (hold their knees) amazing!” (tickle their tummy) Repeat “Jesus (hold their feet) is (hold their knees) amazing!” (tickle their tummy) Repeat



**Cuddle Time**

Cuddle with your child this month and pray, “Dear God, every time we see it rain or hear the thunder, help us remember that Jesus has the power to do anything. If Jesus can tell a storm what to do and it obey Him, then I know He has the power to do whatever we need in our lives. Thank You for loving us and for sending Jesus to be our friend forever. We love You, God. In Jesus’ name, amen.”



**Drive Time**

Give your child something special to carry as you drive or take a walk. Tell them to take very good care of it and don’t drop it. Talk about the four friends who carried their friend to see Jesus. They heard Jesus could make their friend all better so they carried him all the way to see Jesus!



**Bath Time**

Add small toy plastic fish to bath time, or any small plastic toy item. You can always pretend they are fish. Tell your child you are going to count to ten, and they are going to “catch” as many fish as they can before you get to ten. Line the fish along the side of the tub and count them together. Talk about how Jesus helped the fishermen

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**Say This**

Who loves you?  
*Jesus loves me.*

**Luke 18:15-16**

Jesus tells His disciples to let the children come to Him.

**Do This**



**Morning Time**

When you go into your child's room, say, "I see someone Jesus loves and it's...YOU!" (Tickle your child when you say, "YOU.")



**Cuddle Time**

Cuddle with your child this month and pray, "Dear God, thank you for sending Jesus to be our friend forever. No one loves us and helps us like Jesus. You are the best, God. In Jesus' name, amen."



**Drive Time**

Listen as you drive or take a walk and name all the different sounds you hear. Tell your child to really listen, just like Mary listened so she could hear Jesus. How many different sounds can you hear?



**Bath Time**

Add some items to bath time that your child can use to scoop and pour water. As your child scoops and pours the water, talk about how the woman in the Bible story poured perfume on Jesus to show Him how thankful she was that He loved her no matter what.

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**Say This**  
Who can love like Jesus?  
*You can love like Jesus.*

**John 13:3-17**  
Jesus washes His disciples' feet to show them how to love one another.

**Do This**



**Morning Time**

When you go into your child's room, say, "Good morning! I see someone who can love like Jesus, and their name is (child's name)!" Pick your child up or cuddle them close when you say their name.



**Cuddle Time**

Cuddle with your child this month and pray, "Dear God, Jesus loves everyone. That means [name of child] and I should love everyone. Please help us to love everyone so we can be a good friend the way Jesus is a good friend. We love You, God. In Jesus' name, amen."



**Drive Time**

As you drive or take a walk, take turns naming people you see that you can love like Jesus. Say, "I can love [person you see] like Jesus loves me!"



**Bath Time**

Add dolls or action figures to bath time. Encourage your child to wash the toys' feet while you wash your child's feet. Talk about how Jesus washed His disciples' feet to show us how to love one another.
