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Say This
Who wants to be your friend forever?
Jesus wants to be my friend forever.

Matthew 26:20-30; 27:45-50; 28:1-7
People hurt Jesus so bad that He dies, but on the third day, Jesus comes back, just like He said.

Do This



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, say, "Good morning! It is an amazing day because Jesus is alive and He wants to be our friend forever!"



Drive Time

As you drive or take a walk, talk about how Jesus made fish and bread for His friends to eat for breakfast. Ask your child, "If Jesus made breakfast for you, what would you want Him to make?"



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child this month and pray, "Dear God, thank You for the Church. Thank You for Jesus. Help (name of child) and me be willing to share our food, clothes, and home so we can be a good friend the way Jesus is a good friend. We love You, God. In Jesus' name, amen."



Bath Time

Add plastic toy people to bath time. (Action figures totally work, too!) Encourage your child to line them up on the tub and say to them, "Jesus is alive and He wants to be your friend forever." Talk about how Jesus told all of His friends to make sure everyone everywhere knows that He loves them and wants to be their friend forever.

Whose way is perfect?
God's way is perfect.

Genesis 1:31; 2:8-3:24
God creates the world and puts Adam and Eve in a garden, but they do not go God's way.

Do This



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, say, "Good morning! God made another beautiful day for us to go His way!"



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child this month and pray, "Dear God, thank You for all of the people at church that teach [name of child] that Your way is perfect. Help me to live like I believe Your way is perfect so I can teach [name of child] that truth here at home. We love You, God. In Jesus' name, amen."



Drive Time

As you drive or take a walk, take turns naming things you see that God made. Talk about how God made a perfect world and put Adam and Eve in charge of it. And just like Adam and Eve, we have the choice to go God's way or our way.



Bath Time

Add plastic fruit and flowers to bath time along with a small watering can. Encourage your child to use the watering can to "make it rain" on the fruit and flowers so they can grow. Talk about how God made all of the fruit trees, plants, and flowers when He made the world.

The better you know your kid, the greater your influence.

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Say This

Who can trust God?
You can trust God.

Joshua 5:13-6:27

Joshua trusts God’s plan and obeys, even though it does not make sense to him.

Do This



Morning Time

When you go into your child’s room, say, “Good morning! I see a big [name of child] smile! Do you know why [name of caretaker] is smiling? *(pause)* Because God loves you and me SO much!”



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child this month and pray, “Dear God, thank You for another amazing day with [name of child]. Thank You for teaching us about how we can trust You. Please help [name of child] and me to always trust Your plans because Your plans are always best. We love You, God. In Jesus’ name, amen.”



Drive Time

As you drive or take a walk, take turns naming things that make you feel afraid. Say the memory verse together, “I trust in God. I am not afraid” (Psalm 56:11). Talk about how we don’t have to be afraid when we trust God.



Bath Time

Add blocks to bath time. Encourage your child to stack them on the edge of the tub, count to seven, and then knock them down. Talk about how Joshua trusted God and followed His plan. And it worked! The wall around Jericho fell down! Talk about how we can trust God’s plan for us, too.
