There is always so much going on to update you with. Thank you for your continued support of the ministry and here are just a few highlights:

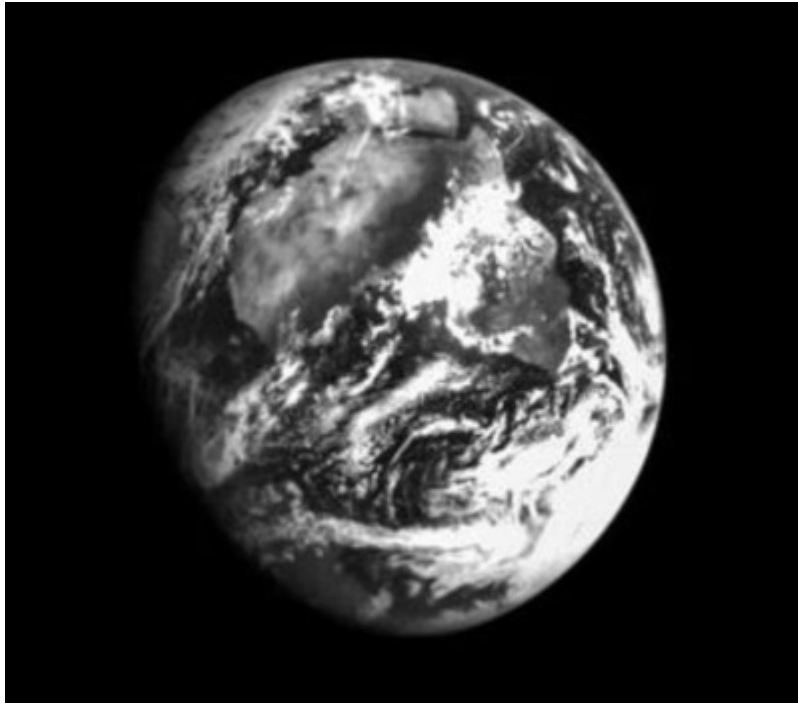
- Bible Study continues to go well and we even have others joining us from out of state via video calls
