- Commitment to our vision: we're working towards reaching everyone on the Front Range of Colorado with the good news of Jesus
- Commitment to our core values: we're a crazy generous, daringly creative, intentionally improving, Bible-driven, kingdom-minded, tribe
- Agreement with our doctrinal statement (nothing radical here, we're a Bible-driven church that's part of Converge Worldwide)
- Feels that God may be calling them to a career in vocational ministry in either a local church or parachurch setting
- Demonstrates interest, passion, and some experience in the ministry area that they wish to join
- Willing to learn and grow in the areas of Heart (Christian character), Head (knowledge) and Hands (practical skills)
- Humble attitude, servant hearted, team player, good work ethic, enthusiastic, flexible, proactive learner, teachable, takes responsibility and is open to constructive feedback
