- Demonstrates a clear commitment to and love for children with special needs and their families
- Team player, strong leader, shepherd, servant's heart, active learner, flexible, problem solver, and enthusiastic
- Partnering skills, organizational skills, self-starter, contributor, communication skills, and a servant leader
- Ability to recruit, motivate, equip, and manage Serve team members
- · Hands on experience with children who have special needs
- Ability to "think on toes" and problem solve accordingly

WHAT YOU'LL DO:

- Provide leadership for the Buddy Ministry families and Serve team
- · Provide training to equip Serve team throughout the year and oversee their recruitment and onboarding process
- Recruit and develop high capacity Serve team members to help support the Buddy Ministry
- Management of the Sensory room for weekend services
- Consistently communicate with families and Serve team and be the face of the Buddy Ministry
- Coordinate the weekly scheduling and pairing of buddies/students
- Consistently connect with new families and provide continual support to families
- Paperwork management (intake forms, snap shots, etc.)
- Develop and implement special needs curriculum plans and child action plans as needed
- Attend team meetings on a regular basis
- Assist the Director with and participate in Sports Camp and special events as needed
- Meet regularly with the Kids Coordinator | Elementary to pursue ongoing spiritual and professional growth opportunities
