Care Fair – Humanitarian aid distribution. continues weekly, helping refugees in material need, in 2024 we provided 3500 aid packages (which includes, clothes, food items, Hygiene products and clothes for kids) also we were able to help with tons of second hand clothes) We are happy that we are able to continue supporting refugees in this practical way thanks to God's grace and generosity of donors. Thank you for being part of that! Please continue to pray for God's provision and wisdom in organizing and distributing the aid so that it reaches those in real need.

Spanish Classes.

For several months, Robert has been teaching Spanish at OM, we have a group of 5 students. Most of them are Ukrainian and even a friend from Afghanistan and Tajikistan joined our classes, it is a great time to connect and create friendships with the students who are very interested in learning this beautiful language.



Bible study.

In the same way, Roberto with another friend started a Bible study in English months ago. It has been a great opportunity to share with some foreign believers, as well as with people who are taking their first steps in the faith, among them an Iranian who told us that he wanted to give Christianity a chance. In the same way an agnostic woman from Uzbekistan, who came with very sincere questions about the Bible.



We were able to give her one in her language, and she came back to our activity, she told us how she has begun to believe in Jesus, Glory to God! Another Muslim friend has started reading the Bible and even made his first prayer with us to finish that week's Bible study.

Seniors' club.

Our seniors continue to “travel” to different countries every Friday. At our seniors' club in Russian on Fridays we continue to present different countries and include the Gospel through it. The seniors love it and continue to come faithfully every week. It's great to see some of them stay after the activity to talk with each other and with us. They were also very excited to see photos of Timoteo as if they were his grandparents. It's great to see these relationships grow. We pray for our seniors that they would open their hearts to Jesus.



Leadership Training.

Last November, Roberto had the opportunity to participate in a leadership training which was conducted for missionaries serving in Africa and Europe. It was a very important time to learn new tools that can be applied to our ministry and lead it in a more effective way.

Christmas.

Last Christmas was very different for us, being very close to Timoteo's due date we shared a dinner with friends. We sang some praises and prayed, Some of the people who came are the ones we served, they were very excited since it was their first Christmas, including Mateo (our friend from a Muslim background), we told him that we were glad to see him here and his answer was: where else would I go? You are my family now!



Mobilisation.

The work in this country is considerable, and we believe that the church should be involved in the Great Commission. Despite the fact that the Polish evangelical church is small in number (around 0.2%) and the high rates of migrants from Muslim, Hindu, and Buddhist backgrounds, we all play a key role in the expansion of the gospel. In recent months, we have had the opportunity to share in several churches through preaching, workshops, and programs for children.



Revive

Last December Revive took place in Poland, a conference whose objective is to promote a revival in university students throughout Europe. This movement takes place annually, we represented OM at the international level with a stand. Our idea was to create relationships with the participants, share about the ministries we offer and motivate them to be part of one of them either for short or long term.

Robert had been coordinating this effort for months, however he had to delegate this project at the end, since the event was to be held 4 hours away from where we live, precisely on dates that could coincide with Timoteo's birth.

During those days the OM team was able to pray and talk with hundreds of young people, many of them eager to take steps of faith.



Latinos

The arrival of Latinos in Poland is growing rapidly, especially Colombians and Venezuelans, many of whom are seeking work, while others are in refugee centers.

Sadly, many are exploited or scammed upon arrival, having spent their money on tickets and paperwork, and they find themselves without contacts, without knowledge of the language, and without a place to live. In recent weeks, we have helped about 10 people in this situation, many of whom are terrified and unsure of what to do.



Additionally, we are working with Latinos in nearby regions, supporting a church that is actively working with them. We ask for your prayers for this situation and for wisdom and contacts to be able to help more. Thank you!
