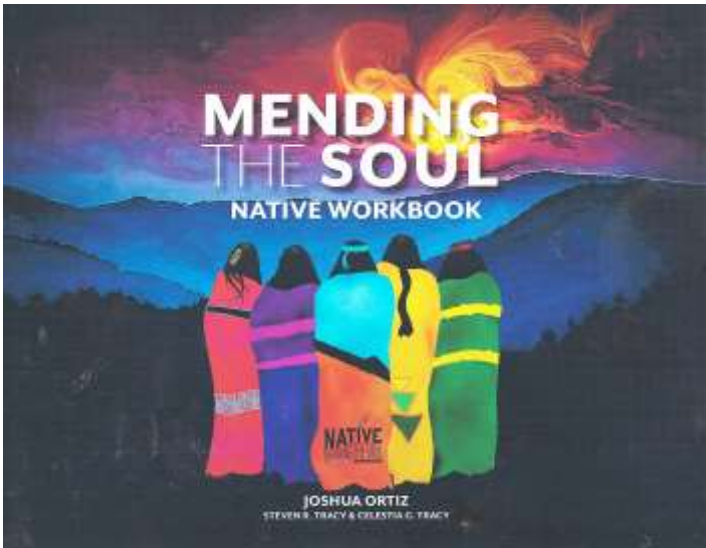

No matter which mission agency, do you know the number one reason missionaries quit and return home from the field; inability to get along with other missionaries. Yep! You see, we missionaries can be quite strong-willed and stubborn! This comes in mighty handy as we pioneer new outreach opportunities, but it also has its downsides.

During our biennial 4-day staff retreat in the mountains above San Diego, we completed 10 sessions on Peace-making. Conflict resolution is a critical skill for ministry longevity. I'm in my 50th year of missionary service and I've seen many schisms and have been a part of my fare share of disagreements. Only by God's grace are we still serving!



I filmed all 10 sessions, which after many impending hours of editing, will be used to train new missionary candidates.

Disharmony has been such a hindrance to the spread of the Gospel that Pioneers is mandating all 3,000+ of its missionaries go through the course. For one thing, it gives us all a common language and process through which we can work to try and reach mutual agreement on matters of dispute.

Well, now that the cat is out of the bag, missionaries aren't perfect, you'll know how to pray better for your missionaries and for Leslie and I! Satan LOVES to cause division, the exact opposite of what Christ told us should set us apart from others; "By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another".
