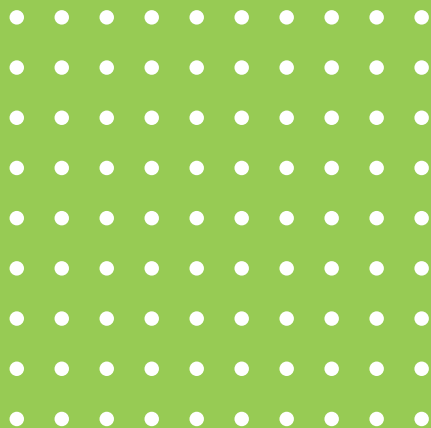

WEEK 1

This March preschoolers will learn that they are meant to know God with our Big Deal, “Ready, Set Grow! God Wants Me to Know Him!” We will teach preschoolers amazing things they can know about God: He is holy, He never changes, He is both just and kind, and He is wise.

Our Bible story this week is from Isaiah 6. Isaiah recognized that God is holy, meaning He is set apart, perfect, and good. When Isaiah came face to face with God’s holiness, Isaiah also recognized that he was not holy. Even still, God wanted Isaiah to know and follow Him—and Isaiah did! Preschoolers can know that God is special and different than anyone or anything, and He invites us to know Him and follow Him too.



PRESCHOOL

BIG DEAL: GOD IS HOLY

READ: Isaiah 6

HIGHLIGHT: Isaiah 6:3

REFLECT: What aspect of God's holiness most inspires you to trust and follow Him?

- A.** God is separate, which means He is totally different and more special than anything or anyone.
- B.** God is perfect, which means everything He says and does is right and trustworthy.
- C.** God is good, which means that His plans are always best.

PRAY: God, help me recognize Your holiness and respond by following You like Isaiah did. You are set apart, perfect, and good. Help me trust You in everything and obey You in all things. Amen.

CONNECT: How would you respond if asked, "How big is God?"

WEEK 2

We get to share several Bible stories with preschoolers this week as we teach that God never changes. Throughout these stories in the Bible, we can see that God makes and keeps promises. The same God who made promises to people like Adam and Eve, Abram, Moses, and Jeremiah is the same God who invites us into a forever friendship with Him. Preschoolers will know they can always count on God because He never changes.



PRESCHOOL

BIG DEAL: GOD NEVER CHANGES

READ: Genesis 3:1-15; 12:1-3; Hebrews 8:7-13

HIGHLIGHT: Hebrews 8:10-12

REFLECT: What characteristics of God in the Bible can you share with someone this week?

- A.** God is gracious and promises love and grace, even when we sin. (Genesis 3:1-15)
- B.** God is active, working through us to bless other people and help them know Him. (Genesis 12:1-3)
- C.** God is relational, promising to love and lead those who love and follow Him. (Deuteronomy 29:1-15; Hebrews 8:7-13)

PRAY: God, it is amazing that You are the same yesterday, today, and forever. As I remember all You did in the Bible and all You have done in my life, help me share those amazing stories with others. Amen.

CONNECT: How can knowing stories about God fulfilling His promises in the Bible encourage you to follow Him? What stories stand out to you?

WEEK 3

As we help preschoolers see that God wants them to know Him, we will teach an incredible Bible story this week. In Genesis 6–9:17, God punished sin by sending a flood that destroyed the earth, but God rescued a man named Noah by telling him to build an ark for his family and many animals. When the floodwaters receded, God placed a rainbow in the sky as a reminder that He would never flood the earth again. Through this Bible story, preschoolers will learn that God is just, meaning He always does what is right, and He is kind, meaning He always does what is loving and helpful. We see this most through God’s justice in punishing our sin and His kindness in sending Jesus to take the punishment we deserve.



PRESCHOOL

BIG DEAL: GOD IS JUST AND KIND

READ: Genesis 9:1-17

HIGHLIGHT: Genesis 9:13-15

REFLECT: What is helpful for you to reflect on this week?

- A.** God is just, meaning He always does what is right.
- B.** God is kind, meaning He always does what is loving and helpful.
- C.** God is just and kind, meaning I can trust the balance that He will always do what is both right and loving.

PRAY: God, thank You for the justice and the kindness You show every day. Thank You for sending Jesus to take the punishment for sin so I can have a relationship with You. Amen.

CONNECT: What helps you continue to trust and follow God, even through difficult times?

WEEK 4

This week preschoolers will learn that God is wise. In Daniel 2, a king had a dream and searched for someone to reveal it to him and interpret its meaning. When Daniel was approached with this task, he recognized and drew attention to the truth that only God can do something like that. We will teach preschoolers that, like Daniel, we can look to God for wisdom and trust Him because He is wise.



PRESCHOOL

BIG DEAL: GOD IS WISE

READ: Daniel 2:1-30

HIGHLIGHT: Daniel 2:20-22

REFLECT: What is a new or different way you can learn from God's wisdom?

- A.** Start a new Bible plan or Bible study.
- B.** Spend time with a wise, godly person.
- C.** Take time to pray and listen to God.

PRAY: God, Your wisdom is incomparable and can always be trusted. Help me look to You for wisdom, direction, and guidance. Help me trust what You say. Amen.

CONNECT: What are ways you can show others God and honor Him, like Daniel did when he said wisdom belongs to God?
