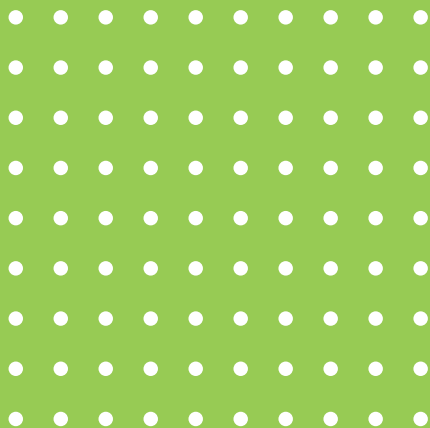

# WEEK 1

This May we are teaching your preschoolers that God wants them to tell people about Jesus. God wants all of us—from the smallest to the tallest—to share about Jesus here and now! The good news of who Jesus is and why He came is important and exciting. Sharing Jesus is God's plan and always worth it. This week we are talking about a man named Paul who told about Jesus in many different places. In our Bible story from Acts 13–21, preschoolers will see that **sharing Jesus is important** and that God can work through us to help other people know, love, and follow Him. We will finish our month out with a special Hooray Day, where we will teach preschoolers that God leads us to have faith.

# BIG DEAL: SHARING JESUS IS IMPORTANT

**READ:** Acts 13

**HIGHLIGHT:** Acts 13:47-48

**REFLECT:** Which truth and Bible verse would be helpful to know when you have the opportunity to share Jesus with others?

- A.** Jesus is the only way to God the Father.  
(John 14:6)
- B.** Sin deserves punishment, but Jesus offers forgiveness.  
(Romans 6:23)
- C.** We do not have to work to earn God's love or salvation.  
(Ephesians 2:8)

**PRAY:** God, the gift of Your love and salvation through Jesus is the most important truth I could share with others. Thank You for this gift. Help me remember that sharing Jesus is important. Open doors for me to share the good news of Jesus with others. Amen.

**CONNECT:** Who are people in your life and community that would benefit from hearing the good news of Jesus? What can you do to allow God's light to shine through you in their lives?

# WEEK 2

We believe that God has a plan for your preschoolers, and part of that plan is to share Jesus with others! This week we are teaching about how after Jesus died on a cross and rose from the dead, He appeared to two disciples walking on a road to a place called Emmaus. The disciples did not recognize Jesus, but Jesus shared with them that all of Scripture pointed to God's plan for the promised Savior to die for sins and come back to life. God's plan also includes sharing the truth about Jesus with the world. We cannot wait for your preschoolers to learn about being part of God's plan!

# BIG DEAL: SHARING JESUS IS GOD'S PLAN

**READ:** Luke 13-49

**HIGHLIGHT:** Luke 24:46-47

**REFLECT:** What helps you recognize who Jesus is and what His plan is for His followers?

- A.** Spending time alone with God.
- B.** Talking with others who love God.
- C.** Worshiping and enjoying music about Jesus.

**PRAY:** God, it is amazing to know that Your plan for salvation through Jesus has been Your plan from the beginning of the world. Help me see and participate in my part of Your plan—sharing the good news of Jesus with others. Amen.

**CONNECT:** How has Jesus surprised you recently? How can recognizing what Jesus has done in your life remind you that sharing Jesus is God's plan?

# WEEK 3

Preschoolers are learning this month that God wants us to share Jesus with others. This week they will learn that **sharing Jesus is worth it**. In Matthew 13:1-23, Jesus told a story about a farmer sowing seed on different types of soil. While not all the seed grew, the seed sown on good soil grew and multiplied. We can know that when we share Jesus, not everyone will listen and believe (like the seed sown on the other types of soil). However, sharing Jesus is worth it because God is the One who can make a “seed” of faith grow in our lives.

# BIG DEAL: SHARING JESUS IS WORTH IT

**READ:** Matthew 13:1-23

**HIGHLIGHT:** Matthew 13:23

**REFLECT:** Thinking about the story that Jesus told, what can motivate you to share Jesus, even when it is challenging or seems hopeless?

- A.** God is the One who knows what seeds of faith will grow.
- B.** God is pleased when I share Jesus, even if people do not believe.
- C.** God can work through me when I share, even if I do not see the results.

**PRAY:** Thank You, God, for helping my faith in Jesus grow like seed in good soil. Help me share Jesus and know that it is always worth it, even when the soil seems rough. Amen.

**CONNECT:** What steps do you take to improve the spiritual “soil” of your life and keep growing in your relationship with Jesus? How can your faith story remind you that **sharing Jesus is worth it?**

# WEEK 4

In Acts 2, the first followers of Jesus were gathered together when something amazing happened! God sent the Holy Spirit, and they were empowered to share Jesus with boldness. As they shared, people heard them speaking in their own languages, and many people believed in and trusted Jesus that day. Preschoolers will learn that **sharing Jesus is exciting**, and God can work through us in incredible ways, here and now!

**READ:** Acts 2

**HIGHLIGHT:** Acts 2:40-41

**REFLECT:** The disciples in the early church witnessed amazing things when they were filled with the Holy Spirit. Which one do you think is most exciting?

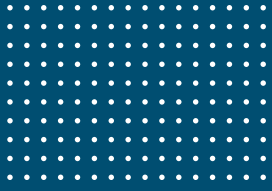
- A.** The way the disciples were empowered with boldness

- C.** The rapid growth that happened in the church

**PRAY:** God, the same Holy Spirit that You poured out on Pentecost is the same Holy Spirit that fills Christians today. Fill me with boldness and help me share Jesus with passion. May I always remember that sharing Jesus is exciting. Amen.

**CONNECT:** Recall a time you told someone about Jesus. What happened? How can our own stories and stories from others show that sharing Jesus is exciting?

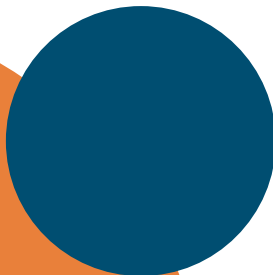

**READ:** Hebrews 11

**HIGHLIGHT:** Hebrews 11:1-3

**REFLECT:** What step of faith is God currently calling you to take?

- A.** Turn away from sin and trust Him for healing.
- B.** Say yes to an opportunity that seems challenging or uncomfortable.
- C.** Boldly share Jesus with someone.

**PRAY:** God, You have given me so many examples of faith-filled people in the Bible and in my own life. Deepen my faith, helping me to live fully for You. Help me know that You are good, loving, and always with me. Thank You that my faith is secure because You sent Jesus to make the way to have a relationship with You—and nothing will change that. Amen.

**CONNECT:** Whose faith has inspired your faith journey?
